Scripture Reflection

A wedding couple chose Matthew 5:14, "You are the light of the world," as their Gospel. Why? Because they give a light to others in their daily work, and their marriage will shine the light of Christ, too. As individuals and as a couple, they testify to the Light that no darkness can overcome, Jesus Christ, whose coming we celebrate today. Our world needs that light.

A few years ago, Mass was celebrated in an Iraqi church that had been devastated by ISIS troops. Light! Pope Francis signed a joint declaration with Lutheran Bishop Munib Younan, pledging to improve relations between Catholics and Lutherans. Light! Six-year-old Alex wrote President Obama, asking the president to bring a Syrian refugee boy to his home: "We will give him a home and he will be our brother." Light! The border between the U.S. and Mexico was opened for three minutes so families could reunite for a short time. Light!

Luke's baby of Bethlehem, wrapped in swaddling clothes and laid in a manger, is first presented in John's Gospel as the eternal Word of creation, as light shining in the darkness, as the Father's only Son, and finally, as the Word become flesh who dwelled among us, true God and true man. Give yourself time over these days to *ponder* (a good Christmas word) not only the babe in the crèche but also the profound mystery of the Word of God in whom and through whom all things were made.

We testify to the light of Christ whenever we give flesh to his light. The Word becomes flesh in us. It need not be something big. Nothing is small in the service of God. Our work, our family life, the way we treat one another, the respect we show those with whom we disagree, a smile, a hug, or a handshake---all make clear that God dwells among us. People see God present in our midst. How beautiful are the feet of those who live God's good news. Merry Christmas!


