

Day of Fasting and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Abstinence refers to not eating meat at all on those days. Persons 14 years of age and older are to abstain. Fasting refers to one full meal, with two small meals, no eating between meals. People who have reached their 18th birthday and up to their 59th birthday are obligated to fast. In addition to these obligations, additional forms of fast and abstinence may be observed.

THE BLESSING OF EASTER FOOD BASKETS

The traditional blessing of Easter Food Baskets will take place at Our Lady of Fatima Church at Noon on Holy Saturday. A handout is available at the 13th Avenue entrance describing the symbolic value of different Eastern European food.

Easter Water/Holy Water

A limited number of bottles of Blessed Easter Water will be available for use in the home. They will be near the baptismal font.

Visiting Seven Churches on Holy Thursday Night

There is a custom of visiting 7 churches on Holy Thursday night in commemoration of the seven final stops/places in our Lord's life: 1) Garden of Gethsemane, 2) Before Annas, 3)Before Caiaphas, 4)Before Pilate, 5) Before Herod, 6)Before Pilate again, and 7)Jesus crucifixion and death. The custom is credited to St. Philip Neri and is practiced by Catholics around the world, especially in Poland, Mexico, Italy, and the Philippines.
